

AN EXPLANATION OF GRADES USED IN THE YEAR 12 AND YEAR 13 GRADE REPORTS

Target A2 / AS Grade (TG)

Target grades are calculated from recent national data that maps students' average GCSE results to their subsequent AS and A2 results. Achieving these target grades would place a student one grade higher than average students nationally.

Predicted Grade (PG)

This assessment is the overall grade a student will achieve when they sit the AS or A2 exam in the summer if they continue to produce the same quality of work with the same level of effort as they are currently demonstrating.

Pre-Public Exam Grade and REP (Reported Exam Percentage)

The grades presented are based solely on your child's performance in the PPEs.

Raw exam marks have been converted to REP percentages. The REP percentage boundaries are the same across all subjects so, for example, a REP of 65% will mean a solid grade C in all subjects.
