Target A Level Grade (TG)

This is given as an indication of the final grade that your son/daughter should achieve in a subject.

Target grades are calculated from recent national data that maps students' average GCSE results to their subsequent A2 results. Achieving these target grades would place a student one grade higher than average students nationally

Predicted Grade (PG)

This assessment is the overall grade a student will achieve when they sit the A2 exam if they continue to produce the same quality of work with the same level of effort as they are currently demonstrating.
