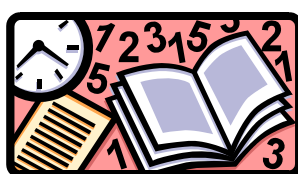

This is on a Friday after school from 4 till 5 in M5. It is linked to a special exam paper sat in the spring.
