In the third module you will have the opportunity to do a piece of coursework, part of which is a personal investigation: to produce a piece of work based on your own research and out teaching. It is based around two determined men who had much in common, but who were in different political parties, and who detested each other. This personal investigation can be on any issues or link related to the two men – virtually a free choice. **In the fourth module you will look at a theme in history over a hundred year period, thus studying something in depth and in breadth. This will focus is on the struggle of citizens in the United States to gain equality before the law without regard to ethnic origin, gender or wealth.**
