Top 3 Priorities for Local Community – discussion with Police Sergeant Mike Tripp	<p>Frazer and Lizzie welcomed Sgt Tripp. Sgt Tripp keen to collect views and liaise with Parish Councils etc. Sgt Tripp keen to redress the balance in terms of the view of the general public towards young people.</p> <p>Mike Turner introduced the key priorities as highlighted after consultation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Issue of the toilets/bus shelter in relation to road safety – it's demolition would improve the access to the school for traffic and pedestrians because you could widen the access. 2. Issue of undesirables who collect outside of the toilets. A discussion surrounded the effect of anti-social behaviour. This behaviour included in some of the other villages i.e. Axbridge Square. 3. More youth based activities for young people. Different types of organisations and activities were discussed. This is particularly an issue in winter months. It was acknowledged that there are groups/activities like the Cheddar Youth Club but it is only once a week and not well publicised. Sgt Tripp explained that there has been an increased level of funding to improve facilities and opening hours. Sgt Tripp to ensure that we receive publicity materials. 4. Ollie Crandon opened the question of public transport. Almost £5 for a junior ticket to Weston. Some of the outlying villages have very little indeed. From Wedmore Golf Club -> Weare – once a week service designed for the elderly to go to Tesco. The Summer all day junior tickets are now nearly £7. Issue of supply and demand was discussed in relation to transport and laid on activities. 		Sgt Tripp
