As a parent of a student who attends The Kings of Wessex School, I wish to express my support for the School's proposal concerning the demolition of the Station Road toilets, to make way for improvements to the access road into the school.

Who in Cheddar has not been caught up in the traffic and road chaos at the entrance to the school during rush hour traffic? I find it most pleasing that the students at the school are getting involved in their community and coming up with very positive suggestions to improve their local environment. I was not previously aware of any actual traffic accidents involving student pedestrians but, having been informed of such issues, I can only back these suggested improvements and hope the Council move this issue forward rapidly.

I cannot believe that the toilets give any major benefit to the community. The only issue around them is the congregation of a number of youths and a focal point for young car drivers. Their removal would appear to be most beneficial in this regard and clearly offer the options of improving access to the school. Personally I cannot see any down-side to this suggestion; if the Council are aware of one I would be most interested to know of it.

I hope that you will take my view into account when considering the proposal.
