The Guide

This booklet is an outline for students, parents and carers for the next 10 school weeks in light of the government guidelines announced on 25 February for students entered for qualification in the Summer 2021 series.

It is written as a countdown from week 10 to 1, week 10 commenced this week, 8 March, with students return to school. Week 1 is week commencing 24 May when the completion and submission of all evidence will have to take place.

This guide is being presented to help support students focus their preparation and revision to help them demonstrate the progress they have made.

The subject pages refer to the different components and topics in each subject and the assessment to be taken. There are a number of abbreviations you may find helpful;

CA – controlled assessment

AO – assessment objective

LA – learning aim

NEA – non-examined assessment

LO – learning objective

Class codes have been referred to in some option subjects e.g. 11B Year 11 class in block B identified from the timetable code on Firefly. The change in language between qualifications is a reflection of the relevant exam board specifications. The subjects are listed in alphabetical order.

The Schedules

The assessments will be completed in class time on the stated week and will be fully supported. As previously mentioned, access arrangements will be in place for students over these assessment periods. Two assessment periods have been identified from 22 March to 1 April and from 10 to 28 May to enable subjects to focus on the different components and topics. Any assessment will be used to provide further evidence when teachers make academic judgements on a student's grade.

Please do not feel daunted by the information in this booklet. Start by crossing out the pages that cover subjects that do not apply to you. Remember you only need to focus on one week at a time. Tick off each week as you cover it. If you start to give regular time to purposeful preparation, then you will find as the weeks go by you will be well-placed to achieve your potential.

There are many ways of reviewing content and skill. One essential ingredient is planning your time. The last page of this booklet shows an example of a weekly plan. This is also available on the webpage under revision. Alternatively, you may wish to plan your weeks in your own format or use an online planner for example getrevising.co.uk. Whichever format you use for planning your time you will need to have a plan for when you are fitting your preparation into each week and when you are covering each subject.

Remember that it is essential to take breaks and to find time each day when you can switch off and relax. A weekly plan is not only an opportunity to plan your work but also a chance to plan when you will take a break. Work is best approached in short bursts of approximately 30 minutes with short breaks in between.

Please ask your teachers if you are unsure about anything or require any resources, help or advice.

Students have shown great resilience and determination to continue with their studies during each period of national lockdown and we wish each and every student the best of luck for the coming weeks.
