We are very pleased to announce this year's Kings Sixth Holiday Revision programme to support your children with their preparation for the important exam period ahead.

The programme is primarily aimed at Year 13 students, although a few sessions are offered to Year 12 for vocational courses with upcoming exams and assessments.

If your son/daughter is interested in any of these sessions then you will need to complete the application form at the back of this booklet and return it to the academy office by no later than Friday 18 March 2022.

Places are limited and we appreciate that some subjects are on the same day therefore students will need to prioritise. To help us, please indicate preferences in numerical order from the 1st choice through to the least important. We cannot guarantee places but we will attempt to ensure that all students can attend at least one session. We will write to confirm which Holiday Revision sessions your son/daughter has been allocated by Monday 28 March 2022.

Unfortunately due to budgetary constraints, we have to make a small charge towards the costs of the sessions. This charge will be £5 per half day. No payment is required with the application form. Parents / carers will be invoiced for the cost of the sessions once places have been allocated and payment will need to be received **by Monday 4 April 2022** in order for places to be confirmed.

Students attending Holiday Revision sessions will need to make their own arrangements for transport and lunch. They will be able to leave site during the lunch break. The Academy Code of Conduct will apply as normal.

BTEC Performing Arts	Thu 21 April 9.00 – 12.00	DR1	Year 12 students will use this slot to prepare for Unit 1: Investigating Practitioners Work exam. Students will watch recordings of practitioner works and analyse key moments that link to the given theme by BTEC.
