Psychology Revision Workshop – Vue Cinema, Cribbs Causeway Wednesday 19 April 2023

The Psychology Department is delighted to be able to offer the opportunity to attend an intensive one-day revision workshop at Vue Cinema, Cribbs Causeway on Wednesday 19 April 2023. The workshop is run by **tutor2u**, a team of experienced examiners who will focus on both the content and exam techniques for papers 1, 2 and 3. The day will give students a greater insight into the content of the exam and how to approach preparation using relevant and practical exam techniques.

We will leave school at 8.45am and return at approximately 4.15pm. As the start and return time is before and after the end of the school day, it is the responsibility of parents/carers to arrange transport to and from the Academy.

The total cost of the trip is **£47.00** and this includes a detailed revision pack which can be used in preparation to help students focus completely on the essential skills of analysis and evaluation. **The payment deadline is Wednesday 1 February 2023.**

Payment for this trip must be made using the online ParentPay system. The trip will be **available on ParentPay from 9am on Monday 23 January 2023. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.** If you are unable to pay online you can pay by cash at a store showing the Paypoint logo. You will need a Paypoint letter which is available from the school office. The letter has a barcode which is unique to this trip. ParentPay is also used as acceptance of your parental consent confirming that you are satisfied with the arrangements outlined above. Reply slips for consent are no longer issued. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student.

The visit will be covered by the Academy Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for students in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carer you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip. All enrichment activities have a short meeting prior to the date of travel, the date and time of the meeting is circulated via tutors and Firefly. It is essential all students attend these.
