**Re: Easter revision sessions – Booking re-opening**

Due to unexpected availability we are delighted to be able to offer 2 additional days of Geography revision on Tuesday 4 and Thursday 6 April. We also still have spaces available on most other sessions. Booking for all available sessions including the new Geography will **open at 6pm this evening (Thursday 23rd March)** and close on Tuesday 28th March. Details of all sessions are included at the end of this letter.

The Easter revision sessions are offered to supplement the revision schedules which will take place in school. The programme is primarily aimed at Year 13 students, although a few sessions are offered to Year 12 for vocational courses with upcoming exams and assessments.

If your son/daughter is interested in any of these sessions then you will need to book on the booking system <https://kingsofwessexacademy.parentseveningsystem.co.uk> no later than **Tuesday 28 March 2023**. When logging into the booking system you will be required to use your Firefly login.



Students attending Holiday Revision sessions will need to make their own arrangements for transport and lunch. They will be able to leave site during the lunch break. The Academy Code of Conduct will apply as normal.

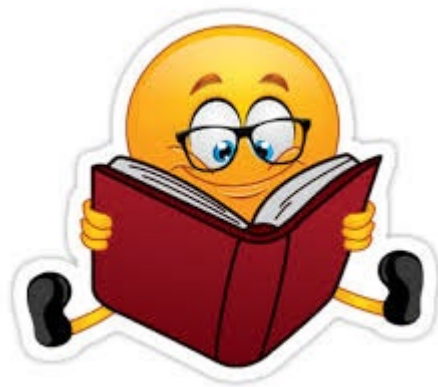
