Dear Parent/Carer and Student

Re: Revision Schedule 10 to 1 and Easter Revision

This letter outlines key information and support for those students who are entered for Level 3 qualifications in the Summer 2023 Examination Series.

The confirmed timetable for the Summer Examination Series can be viewed on the website [here](#). Prior to making plans for the Summer break, please be aware this year there are three National Contingency dates; the afternoons of Thursday 8 and 15 June and the whole day on Wednesday 28 June 2023. Students should remain available up to and including this date. A Level and Level 3 results will be published on Thursday 17 August 2023. Further details of results days will be shared in due course.

I would like to remind you that PPEs (Pre Public Exams) take place from 6 March (next Monday) through to the 14 March. The content of the PPEs was shared in a previous letter. During the PPE week, 6 to 13 March inclusive, students are not expected to attend their lessons and they should use the week as study leave unless they take a vocational subject or subject not listed on the PPE schedule (e.g. Art) in which case they must check with their Teachers.

Accompanying this letter, you will find a **10 to 1 guide and an Easter revision booklet**. The 10 to 1 guide has been written by each subject, for the weeks between now and the start of the 2023 examination series on Monday 15 May. This will signpost students to the suggested topics and/or activities to best prepare them for their examinations in the Summer.

The Easter revision sessions are offered to supplement the revision schedules which will take place in school. The programme is primarily aimed at Year 13 students, although a few sessions are offered to Year 12 for vocational courses with upcoming exams and assessments.

If your son/daughter is interested in any of these sessions then you will need to book on the booking system <https://kingsofwessexacademy.parenteveningsystem.co.uk> no later than Friday 17 March 2023. When logging into the booking system you will be required to use your Firefly login.

Places are limited and will be first come first served. Booking will open at 9am Saturday 4 March. We appreciate that some subjects are on the same day and, therefore, students will need to prioritise. Please note if a session is running all day, due to the content of the day, you will need to attend the full day. You cannot mix it with another session which is running for part of the same day.

There is a small charge towards the costs of the sessions to cover the cost of resources which will be provided. This charge will be £5 per half day. Payment will need to be made via ParentPay by **Friday 24 March 2023** in order for places to be secure. Places will not be secure until full payment for all bookings is received.

Students attending Holiday Revision sessions will need to make their own arrangements for transport and lunch. They will be able to leave site during the lunch break. The Academy Code of Conduct will apply as normal.

All students with PPEs (pre public examinations) in the coming school weeks will have received a briefing in Tutor time this week. Students have had their individual timetables sent to their school email address, alongside receiving a paper copy from their Tutor.
