Protecting against HPV (human papillomavirus vaccine) infection and reducing the risk of cancer. This year we will be offering the HPV Vaccination to all students in school years 8, 9

We are writing to tell you about the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine which has been offered to all girls in school year 8 for over ten years. From September 2019 the vaccine has also been offered to year 8 boys. This is because the evidence is clear that the HPV vaccine helps protect both boys and girls from HPV-related cancers.

The vaccine is given as two separate vaccinations given at least 6 months apart. For further information about the HPV vaccination please visit -
