

What is it?

Each lower school year group will read every Thursday tutor time; sixth form tutor groups read on Tuesday.

Tutors will read to students, and students will follow along in their own copies, or students might read to the class. There are reading rulers for those who wish to follow along with these*.

Tutor groups keep their reading records up to date and on display as part of their tutor board.






- It closes a gap in cultural capital

- To improve literacy




