Dear Parent/Carer

Year 10 Bletchley Park Trip – Friday 12 January 2024

The Maths Department is delighted to be able to offer 40 of our students in the Higher Tier the opportunity to visit Bletchley Park on Friday 12 January 2024. Although the visit is not essential to the GCSE course, it is a fantastic opportunity as students will attend a lecture and workshop on codes and ciphers.

Travel will be by coach from the Kings Academy, leaving at 6.30am and returning at approximately 7.30pm. As the trip leaves and returns before and after the school day, it will be the responsibility of Parents/Carers to arrange transport to and from the school. The total cost of the educational visit will be £42.

The cost will include the following:

- Transport to and from Bletchley Park
- Entrance to the park

Students will need to bring a packed lunch as they will not have the opportunity to buy lunch at the park. They will, however, have the chance to visit the gift shop. The day is non-uniform but students will need sensible shoes and a waterproof coat.

Payment for this trip must be made using the online ParentPay system. The trip will be available on ParentPay from **Wednesday 6 December 2023 at 6.00pm**. If you are unable to pay online you can pay by cash at a store showing the Paypoint logo. You will need a Paypoint letter which is available from the school office. The letter has a barcode which is unique to this trip. ParentPay and barcode letters are also used as acceptance of your parental consent and that you are satisfied with the arrangements outlined above. Reply slips for consent are no longer issued. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student. **Deadline for payment is Thursday 7 December 2023. If the trip is oversubscribed, PLACES WILL BE ALLOCATED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.**

The visit will be covered by the Academy's Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for pupils in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carers you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip. All enrichment activities have a short meeting prior to the date of travel, and the date and time of the meeting is circulated via Tutors and Firefly. It is essential all students attend these.
