

Types of Course

- <u>GCSE</u> Traditional academic focus. Most are assessed by exams only.
- <u>Vocational</u> Work related focus. Continuous assessment throughout the course with some external assessment.
- Learning Support Not necessarily leading to a qualification but providing extra time and support to help some students access the curriculum.
