## Re: Year 11 Easter/May Revision

We are very pleased to announce this year's Year 11 Holiday Revision programme. This programme is to support your students with their preparation for the important exam period ahead. Further details are attached.

If your son/daughter is interested in any of these sessions then you will need to book them on using the booking system <u>here</u> <u>no later than Friday 15 March 2024</u>. When logging into the booking system you will be required to use your Firefly login.

Places are limited and will be first come first served. <u>Booking will open at 9am Saturday 2 March</u>. We appreciate that some subjects are on the same day and, therefore, students will need to prioritise. Please note if a session is running all day, due to the content of the day, you will need to attend the full day. You cannot mix it with another session which is running for part of the same day.

There is a small charge towards the costs of the sessions to cover the cost of resources. This charge will be **£5 per half day**. Payment will need to be made via ParentPay by **Friday 22 March 2024** in order for places to be secure. **IMPORTANT: ParentPay will show a default amount of £5. You will need to amend the total to reflect your bookings i.e. whole day = £10, 3 x half day = £15 etc.** 

All subjects have comprehensive revision programmes within the school term. These Holiday Revision sessions supplement but do not replace them. Revision materials for all subjects are also available on the Firefly website.

Students attending Holiday Revision sessions will need to provide their own packed lunch and transport. There will be no facilities available at school for lunch and students will not be allowed to leave site during lunchtimes. Students do not have to wear uniform. However, exemplary behaviour is expected at all times. We wish all of our Year 11 students the best of luck with preparation for their exams. We know that students will find these Holiday Revision sessions beneficial and a useful addition to their own revision.

The 15 to 1 booklet which outlines suggested revision activities by subject can be found <u>here</u>. In addition, students will attend revision sessions during extended tutor throughout this term and meet with their mentors.
