Dear Parent/Carer

Revision and Examinations for Year 13

I am writing to you with information and advice about how you can support your child whilst they are revising for their upcoming exams. Mr Wiltshire has also written to you to provide an update regarding our outage of information systems due to the cyber-attack. We continue to work to restore and return as soon as possible.

At Kings we have been working with Year 13 through the assembly and tutor programmes on learning how to revise and answer exam papers effectively alongside how students can look after their wellbeing whilst working hard in preparation for their exams. We strive to equip students with the skills they need to tackle their revision confidently and with strategies to look after themselves during this period.

To help you in supporting your son/daughter I would like to draw your attention to specific documents and dates. Firstly, for those students booked into Easter revision sessions, you are reminded full days run from 9:00am until 3:30pm. Students need to be on time as the front doors will not be open throughout the day.

You will find top tips on how to revise, when and where to revise, advice for students on how to look after themselves during this intense period and information about how you can support your child. In addition, there will be an online Parents Information Evening on 23 April at 6.00pm and a link will be sent after the holidays to review this information.

Thirdly, students last day of timetabled lessons will be on Friday 24 May 2024. From this date students will continue to be supported with revision sessions to supplement their independent work. As we get nearer to the exam period, it is now essential that your child has established a good routine for regular revision. This should include revising most evenings, at weekends and in the school holidays. It is also very important that they get the balance right with planned breaks and time to switch off and relax.

Prior to making plans for the Summer break, please be aware the National Contingency afternoons have been identified as the afternoons of the 6 and 13 June 2024. The National Contingency Day is Wednesday 26 June, and all students need to remain available up to and including this date. In addition, the guide to examinations for the 2024 series can also be viewed through the previous link. The results will be published for A Level and Level 3 results on Thursday 15 August 2024. Further details for the results day will be shared in due course. Students and parents will be emailed their individual timetable with exam times and locations. Students will need to look carefully at their individual schedule as they may have an earlier or later time due to access arrangements and some may have a clash.
