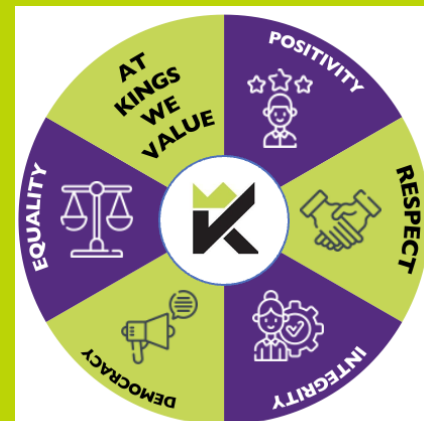


GCSE Exam Information
