Revision Schedules 15 to 1, Preparation and Support

This letter outlines key information and support for those students who are entered for GCSE/Level 2 qualifications in the Summer 2025 Examination Series.

The timetable for the Summer Examination Series can be viewed on the website [here](#). Prior to making plans for the Summer break please be aware there are two National Contingency dates; the afternoon of Wednesday 11 June and the whole day on Wednesday 25 June 2025. Students should remain available up to and including this date. GCSE and Level 2 results will be published on Thursday 21 August 2025. Further details of results days will be shared in due course.

Accompanying this letter, you will find a 15 to 1 Guide. The Guide has been written for each subject, for the weeks between now and the start of the 2025 Examination Series week commencing Monday 5 May 2025. This will signpost students to the suggested topics and/or activities to best prepare students for their examinations in the Summer. Students will be shown and advised further on the effective use of the booklet in school.

Students are currently meeting their mentors one to one or in small groups with a focus on planning their revision. Students are also invited to attend lunchtime and after school revision sessions as appropriate. Many of these sessions are targeted so please do refer to the SchoolCloud system (Parents' Evening system) to check their sessions.

After half term we will share with you details of the Easter revision sessions that will be offered to supplement the revision schedules which will take place in school. Details will be sent later regarding the timetable for both Easter revision and the preparation talks within the examination series.

There will also be an online Parent Information Evening, details of which will be shared separately.

In addition, between 26 February and 7 March 2025 students will take their final set of PPEs. A copy of the timetable is attached and students will receive their personalised copies in due course.
