## New York City - Friday 13 February to Wednesday 18 February 2026

Kings Sixth is delighted to be able to offer 40 students the opportunity to visit New York City from Friday 13 February to Wednesday 18 February 2026. Although the visit is not essential to your child's chosen course of study, it will allow students to encounter experiences that are unavailable in the classroom. The itinerary has been devised to provide students with the chance to experience cultures, respect differences, and thus broaden their horizons and knowledge.

The trip will leave on Friday 13 February 2026 from London Heathrow and return on Wednesday 18 February 2026. The total cost of the trip is £1750 which will be payable in instalments.

Payments are non-refundable. If your child withdraws from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student.
