Kings' Sixth students are celebrating their superb A Level and Level 3 results, which are the best in the last five years. Over 55% of grades achieved were grades A*-B and 80% A*-C. We are also celebrating exceptional vocational results with 100% BTEC Business Diploma and BTEC Sport Diploma students achieving at least one distinction and several students with multiple distinctions.

There were incredible individual achievements including: **Jessica B achieving 3 grade A*s.** Jessica is going to attend the University of Bath to study Business Management and Marketing. **Joshua C, Lola W, Martha W and Chiara T** all achieved two grade A*s and at least one grade A.
