Year 11 Bristol Fieldwork visit – Friday 17 October 2025

The Humanities Department is delighted to be able to offer Year 11 Geography students a trip to Bristol on **Friday 17 October 2025**. This field trip makes up a vital part of how your child is assessed for Geography and allows students to carry out the fieldwork assessed element of the course. The trip will involve an hour tour of Bristol's harbourside regeneration on the Bristol Packet boats, where students will gain a greater understanding of the changes to Bristol's Temple Quarter to further enhance their study. Students will then collect data from around Temple Quarter for their human geographical enquiry.

The trip will leave school via coach at **8.45am** and return at approximately **3.10pm**, in time for the end of school.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water. The day is non-uniform but students will need sensible shoes, loose clothing and waterproofs because of the outdoor, physical nature of the activities.

The Visit will be covered by the Academy Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for students in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carer you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

The total cost of this trip is £14.75. Payment for this trip must be made using the My Child At School App. The trip will be available on the My Child At School App **from 8.00am on Wednesday 24 September 2025**. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student. Deadline for payment is Monday 29 September 2025.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip.
