The English Department is delighted to be able to offer 45 of our Year 11 students the opportunity to watch a performed version of their GCSE novella, The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde. Although the visit is not essential to the GCSE course, it will support your son/daughter with preparation for the English Literature Paper 1 Examination.

The trip will leave school at **9.30am** and return during the school day.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water. Students will need to wear school uniform as they will be returning to school lessons.

The Visit will be covered by the Academy Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for students in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carer you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

The total cost of this trip is £26.50. Payment for this trip must be made using the My Child At School App. The trip will be available on the My Child At School App **from 8.00am on Monday 9 February 2026**. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student. Deadline for payment is Monday 9 February 2026.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip. All enrichment activities have a short meeting prior to the date of travel. The date and time of the meeting is circulated via tutors and Bromcom. It is essential all students attend these.
