Dear Parent/Carer

Year 10 Geography Field Trip to Lyme Regis – Tuesday 19 May 2026

The Geography Department is delighted to offer Year 10 Geography students the opportunity to visit Lyme Regis on Tuesday 19 May 2026. This field trip makes up a vital part of how your child is assessed for Geography. Carrying out fieldwork is an assessed element of the course.

The trip will leave at 8.45am and return at 3.10pm.

It is important that students are fully prepared with the correct attire for their fieldwork. Therefore, your child will need to bring the following:

- Students are advised to wear appropriate footwear for walking i.e. walking boots or sturdy footwear as we will be walking on a pebble beach and covering approximately 5KM during the day
- Appropriate clothing to suit the weather conditions on the day of the trip i.e. waterproof coat and trousers, warm layers, cool clothes or sun hat etc
- Students should also bring any sun cream or medication (e.g. antihistamines or other medication) as required
- Students will need to bring a pencil case, pencil, pen and a rubber
- Rucksack (to carry personal belongings and equipment for data collection)
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Students will also need to bring a packed lunch with snacks and a drink for the day, as there will not be an opportunity for students to buy their lunch on the field trip

The total cost of this trip is £13. Payment for this trip must be made using the My Child At School App. The trip is now available on the My Child At School App. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student.

The visit will be covered by the Academy's Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for pupils in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carers you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.
