The information below is for current Year 11 students, their parents and carers with further information outlining the support for Year 11 students.

Year 11 PPEs

Thank you for your support for students as they undertake their Pre-Public Exams (PPEs) in the March series. Behaviour in the exams has been exceptional. Please do praise your child for their maturity, commitment and resilience. Students will receive their results of the PPEs through class teachers with question level analysis to help them to further focus their revision over the coming weeks. The results of the PPEs and predicted grades will be published to parents at the end of March.

Easter and May Revision

We are very pleased to announce this year's Year 11 Holiday Revision Programme. This Programme is to support your students with their preparation for the important exam period ahead. Further details are attached.

If your son/daughter is interested in any of these sessions then you will need to book them through the Store (School Shop) in your My Child At School (MCAS) parent account.

Places are limited and will be first come first served. Booking will open automatically at midnight on Friday 13 March. We appreciate that some subjects are on the same day and, therefore, students will need to prioritise. Please note if a session is running all day, due to the content of the day, you will need to attend the full day. You cannot mix it with another session which is running for part of the same day.

There is a small charge towards the costs of the sessions to cover the cost of resources. This charge will be **£5 per half day**. Payment will need to be made at the time of booking.

Maths revision sessions will not take place during the holidays as our research and previous years have shown it is more effective immediately before the public exams take place. The Maths team will be offering Saturday morning sessions prior to each public exam taking place. Further details will be shared after the break regarding these.

All subjects have comprehensive revision programmes within the school term. These Holiday Revision Sessions supplement but do not replace them. Revision materials for all subjects are also available through Teams.

Students attending Holiday Revision Sessions will need to provide their own packed lunch and transport. There will be no facilities available at school for lunch and students will not be allowed to leave site during lunchtimes. Students do not have to wear uniform. However, exemplary behaviour is always expected. We wish all our Year 11 students the best of luck with preparation for their exams. We know that students will find these Holiday Revision Sessions beneficial and a useful addition to their own revision.
