Year 12 PPE, Revision and Post 18 Support

The information below is for current Year 12 students, their parents and carers, regarding upcoming events and opportunities to prepare, inform and support students in this important school year.

Revision

Staff will guide students on the revision they should undertake, which may include a topic list or a 5-to-1 revision schedule. Students will also receive further advice on effective revision strategies during their lessons.

Year 12 Mentoring and Revision Sessions Spring Term

Year 12 students are reminded their tutors are there to support them with prioritising and planning their work schedule; identifying and overcoming barriers to learning; understanding the expectations and support available around revision and exam preparation; and getting the most from their lessons and revision sessions. Tutor time is a crucial part of the school day, providing students with key information and important pastoral and academic support.

Year 12 PPEs Monday 27 April to Friday 1 May 2026

PPEs are internal examinations set by subject teachers. These exams use exam board assessment materials and mark-schemes and give students a very authentic experience of sitting examinations which will be excellent preparation for the public examinations. These exams also give students and their teachers valuable information about their current level of performance, their strengths and those areas which they still need to develop to achieve their full potential. Although these results do not count towards final qualification grades, they may influence UCAS predicted grades and progression into Year 13. If students spend time systematically revising and putting in their best effort these exams will be a fantastic opportunity to build confidence and momentum towards success at the end of Year 12. Individual student timetables and the content covered will be communicated during their exam briefing on Monday 30 March 2026.

UCAS and Apprenticeship

We are currently supporting students as they explore their post-18 options. They will receive information about both university and apprenticeship pathways, alongside ongoing guidance through the tutor and assembly programme. This support is designed to help students make informed decisions and develop their post-18 vision.
