Year 9 Eden Trip – Thursday 25 June 2026

The Maths Department is delighted to offer 40 Year 9 students in Maths teaching classes, 9YK, 9YI, 9XK and 9XI, the opportunity to visit the Eden Project on Thursday 25 June 2026. The Maths involved is relatively difficult and the day is designed to be hard work but at the same time challenging and fun.

At the Eden Project, students will take part in two activities. The first has been designed to highlight surveying skills and the use of trigonometry. The second involves using statistical tools to analyse and predict footfall. Students will have an introduction from the Eden Education staff as well as plenty of time to look at the exhibits on their own. The Eden Project is a wonderful place and every year students have a lot of fun on this day.

The trip will leave the academy at 8.30am and return at 8.00pm.

Students will also need to bring a packed lunch with snacks and a drink for the day, as there will not be an opportunity for students to purchase food. Students are able to wear non uniform, must wear sensible shoes, loose clothing and waterproofs because of the outdoor, physical nature of the activities.

The total cost of this trip is £35. Payment for this trip must be made using the My Child At School App. The trip will be available on the My Child At School App at **8.00am on Wednesday 20 May 2026**. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student.

The visit will be covered by the Academy's Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for pupils in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carers you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip. All enrichment activities have a short meeting prior to the date of travel, and the date and time of the meeting is circulated via Tutors and Bromcom. It is essential all students attend these.
