### **Year 12 Geography Fieldwork – South Coast**

We are looking forward to our A Level Geography Fieldtrip from Wednesday 3 June to Friday 5 June 2026. Below is a reminder of the planned itinerary for each day. However, this is flexible dependent on weather conditions to ensure we get the most from our time on the South Coast.

Students need to bring appropriate clothing for days outside, including warm layers and a raincoat in case the weather changes and also sun protection. Students will require sturdy footwear as we will be walking. Suitable comfy trainers are adequate, but a change of footwear for indoors is advisable. All bedding and a towel are provided by the accommodation.

Breakfast is supplied within the cost paid which will be a selection of cereals, toast with preserves and eggs on Thursday and Friday morning. All other meals must be provided or purchased by the students. I would advise students bring a packed lunch or money. There will be plenty of opportunities to purchase lunch. Students will be given the opportunity to eat out at a fast-food location for dinner should they wish. Alternatively, we will also visit a local supermarket where students can purchase food to cook at the accommodation. There is a large kitchen with all utensils needed to enable students to cook a substantial meal, and a dining hall to eat together should they wish.

#### **Wednesday 3 June 2026**

We will leave the Academy on **Wednesday 3 June at 8.00am**. Students are advised to bring their own packed lunch but we will be stopping for lunch in Lyme Regis if they would prefer to buy something from a shop there. We do advise they bring plenty of snacks and water for the morning, even if they plan to buy lunch. After completing data collection in Lyme Regis, we will be visiting Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door for additional coastal learning before heading to our accommodation for the evening.

#### **Thursday 4 June 2026**

We will depart Monkton Wyld Court by 8.30am. Students will be given the opportunity to stop at a shop to purchase lunch for the day. Again, we do advise they bring plenty of snacks and water for the three days. We will be collecting data at Budleigh Salterton and will then explore the local area a little more.

#### **Friday 5 June 2026**

We will depart Monkton Wyld Court by 8.30am. Students will be given the opportunity to stop at a shop to purchase lunch for the day or, alternatively, can make a packed lunch at the accommodation before we leave. Again, we do advise they bring plenty of snacks and water for the three days. We will be collecting data at Exmouth and will then **return to school for approximately 4.00pm**.
