**Supreme Court and Houses of Parliament Trip Tuesday 8 September 2026**

The Social Studies Faculty is delighted to be able to offer 27 Year 13 students the opportunity to visit the Supreme Court and the Houses of Parliament on Tuesday 8 September 2026.

The visit will include a tour of the Supreme Court, after which students will observe an appropriate case from the public gallery. We will then have a tour of the Houses of Parliament followed by a workshop session.

The trip will leave school at 6.00am and return at approximately 9.00pm and, therefore, it is the responsibility of Parents/Carers to arrange transportation to and from the Academy.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water. They should wear clothing appropriate for the location and occasion.

The Visit will be covered by the Academy Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for students in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carer you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

The total cost of this trip is **£68.00**. Payment for this trip must be made using the My Child At School App. The trip will be available on the My Child At School App from **8.00am on Monday 6 July 2026 and is offered on a first come first served basis**. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis from the waiting list. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student. Deadline for payment is Monday 6 July 2026.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip. All enrichment activities have a short meeting prior to the date of travel. The date and time of the meeting is circulated via tutors and Bromcom. It is essential all students attend these.
