The Senedd Trip - Tuesday 6 October 2026

The Politics Department is delighted to be able to offer students the opportunity to visit The Senedd, in Cardiff Bay. Although the visit is not essential to the Politics Course, it is a fantastic opportunity to explore the role of the Senedd, how laws are made, the work of committees and how citizens can influence decision-making. Students will learn about the importance of their vote and how they can make a difference. This session will connect political theory with real-world practice and inspire informed, active participation.

Travel will be by mini-bus from Kings Academy leaving at 10.05am to arrive at The Senedd, in Cardiff Bay for 12:00pm and leave at approximately 3:30pm to arrive back at the Academy for 5.30pm.
The total cost of the educational visit will be £15.

Payment for this trip must be made using the My Child At School App. The trip will be available on the My Child At School App on Monday 21 September 2026 at 8.00am. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please ensure that we have your up-to-date emergency contact details and any relevant medical information for your child, as this information is taken from our school database. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student.

The visit will be covered by the Academy's Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for pupils in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities in the UK.
- As parent/carers you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.

As with all Academy trips, students will be expected to uphold the reputation of the Academy and, therefore, exceptional behaviour is expected at all times throughout the trip and in the lead up to the trip. All

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enrichment activities have a short meeting prior to the date of travel, and the date and time of the meeting is circulated via Tutors and Bromcom.
